

# THE MUST BUY DVD OF 2011 EMERSON LAKE & PALMER

'The 40th Anniversary Reunion of the World's greatest Prog-Rock Band'



After 12 years apart, EMERSON, LAKE & PALMER (ELP) reformed to headline the HIGH VOLTAGE FESTIVAL in London. One of the original "supergroups", their music defined an era, beginning in the seventies. Their incredible 2010 reunion performance is now available for the first time on DVD and Blu-Ray... ...and what a show it is!!


EMERSON, LAKE & PALMER (ELP) reformed for the

first time since 1998 for to headline the HIGH VOLTAGE FESTIVAL on Sunday, July 25th 2010. 2010/2011 marks the 40th anniversary of the creation of Emerson Lake and Palmer.

ELP was a predominant force that laid the foundation for all progressive rock. The band consists of Keith Emerson, the explosive keyboard who came from the Nice, the sultry vocals and extraordinary bass of Greg Lake from King Crimson and the theatrical and extraordinary drumming of Carl Palmer, who emerged from Atomic Rooster.

ELP became the first true prog-rock Super Group and sold nearly 50 million albums. The band went to number 1 in the charts with 'Fanfare For The Common Man' adapted from the 20th Century American classical Composer Aaron Copeland's theme. This unique re-

interpretation of classical music is a hallmark of the band and laid the foundation for progressive rock and the generations of rock and roll that followed. Their fans still number in the millions, world-wide.


